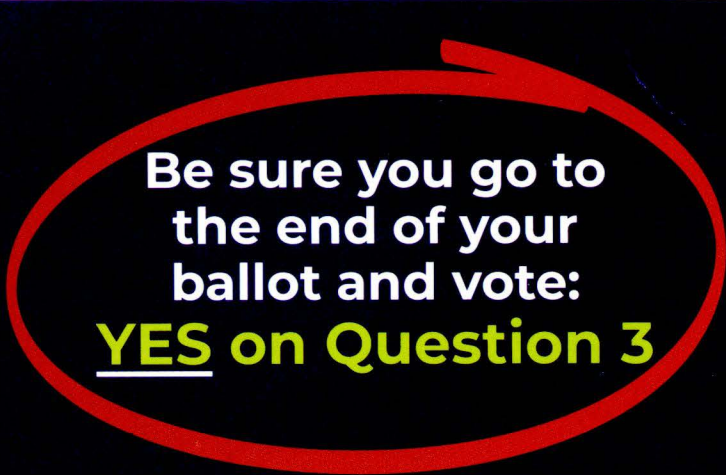
### Provides all registered voters a say in which candidates appear on general election ballots

“Question 3 creates open primaries, so every voter - regardless of party registration - has the right to vote. Giving veterans, and all voters, more voice in who represents us.”

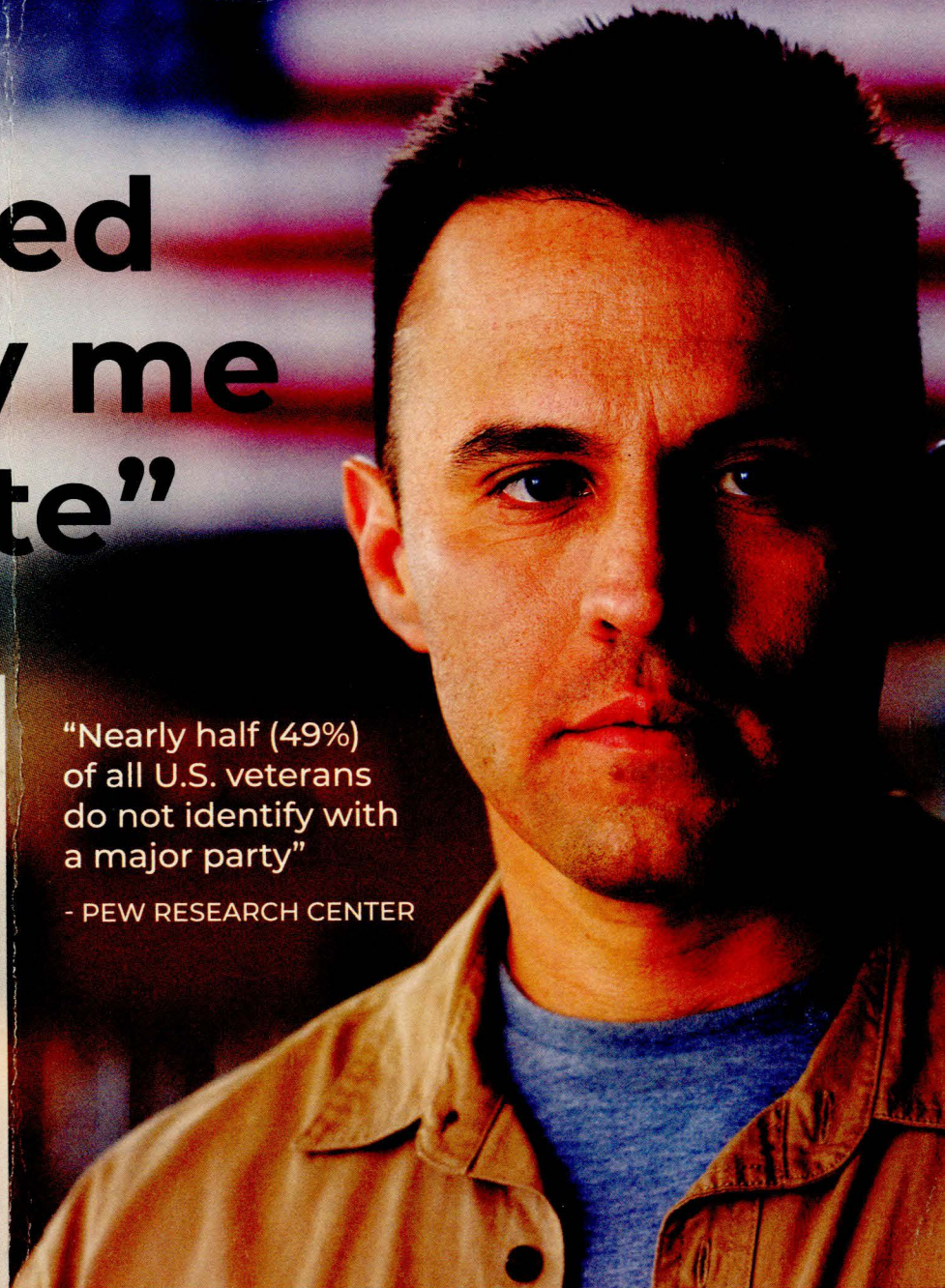
